



## A330 SHIPPER CLEANING PROCEDURE

Equipment Recommended:
Pressure washer
Rain suit / Boots
Eye / hearing protection
Scraper (1 ½" putty knife)
Cotton Towels
Spray bottle for cleaner
Clean mop / bucket with wringer
Hand scrub brush

### CLEANING

- 1) Large areas of product should be scraped off prior to moving the shipper to the wash area.
- 2) Remaining dirty areas of the shipper must be noted before washing begins.
- 3) For stubborn, dry product residue, use "Neugenix 4177" degreaser in spray bottle.

**NOTE: It is much harder to identify dirt when the shipper is wet.**

- 4) Carefully tip the shipper on its side and wash the bottom of the base and the skid pads.
- 5) Carefully tip the shipper back down (DO NOT DROP) and wash the outside of the shipper.

**NOTE: Do not apply pressure washer directly to the Arena serial # labels or scrub the labels.**

- 6) Wash the inside the shipper including all four walls and the bottom.
- 7) Move the shipper to the drying area.

### DRYING

- 1) The shipper must be dried completely before returning to the customer as follows:
  - a. Dry the inside floor of the shipper using a CLEAN standard mop.
  - b. Dry outside and inside wall corrugations using a clean towel.

**NOTE: Do not allow mop to touch the floor or any dirty surface**

- 2) Use fans to keep the work area dry and to finish drying the shippers.

**NOTE: Use a hand jack or forklift to move finished shippers to keep the bottom clean.**
